

WITHDRAWAL OF ADMISSION FORMS

An admission form once submitted may be withdrawn by a Principal, only under the following conditions:

- 1. When a candidate has been sent up Provisionally on account of shortage of attendances and that shortage has not been made up or condoned accordance with the Rules and Regulations. Admission of a candidate who has completed the required percentage of attendances calculated on the basis of lessons given or lectures delivered up to the 14th day before the commencement of Vocational Exam and up to one month before the commencement of other exams cannot be withdrawn.
- 2. When a candidate has been struck off the rolls of the Institution for nonpayment of the Institution dues provided such action has been taken before the commencement of the exam.
- When a candidate has been rusticated or expelled or his character certificate has been withdrawn for misconduct before the commencement of the exam.
- 4. When a candidate has fallen short of the required percentage of attendances after his Form has been sent up and who cannot make up his deficiency before the 16th days preceding the exam.
